SECTION I : GENERAL INFORMATION INTRODUCTION

An Act of Parliament in 1956 established the All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS) as an autonomous institution of national importance and defined its objectives and functions. By virtue of this Act, the Institute awards its own medical degrees and other academic distinctions. The degrees awarded by the Institute under the All India Institute of Medical Sciences Act are recognized medical qualifications for the purpose of the Indian Medical Council Act and notwithstanding anything contained therein, are deemed to be included in the first schedule of that Act, entitling the holders to the same privileges as those attached to the equivalent awards from the recognized Universities of India.

SECTION II : AIMS & OBJECTIVES

In the field of postgraduate education, the most important function of the Institute is to provide opportunities for training teachers for medical colleges in the country in an atmosphere of research and enquiry. Postgraduate students are exposed to newer methods of teaching and given opportunities to actively participate in teaching exercises. The other important objectives of the Institute are to bring together in one place educational facilities of the highest order for the training of personnel in all the important branches of health activity and to attain self-sufficiency in postgraduate medical education. The educational principles and practices being adopted are those which are best suited to the needs of the nation.

SECTION III: APPLICATION PROCESS

1. The online applications are invited from Indian Citizens as per Govt. of India's Residency Scheme, for **Senior Resident/Demonstrator Common Eligibility Test (SRD-CET) for appointment as Senior Residents / Senior Demonstrators** for the tenure period of 3 years (including previous teaching experience in any government organization/ Institution in India) in various departments at AIIMS, New Delhi and AIIMS-CAPFIMS are required to apply online on the website www.aiimsexams.ac.in. These posts include existing vacant posts, backlog vacancies of SC/ST/OBC and those posts which will fall vacant between **01.01.2026 to 30.06.2026**.
2. The aspiring applicants satisfying the eligibility criteria in all respects can submit their application only through **ON-LINE mode**. The Online applications can be done through the website www.aiimsexams.ac.in as per closing dates specified under **Important dates**. No documents, including the Registration Slip of the online application form, are required to be sent in Physical form. Any kind of Physical document regarding registration will be treated as null and void and will be destroyed. **However, all the applicants are advised to keep a copy of the registration slips with them, along with proof of payment, for their records. Correction in registration will not be considered through any mode i.e. Email/letter. Hence, candidates are advised to fill their registration form carefully as no correction will be allowed after specified dates as per the procedure.**
3. It is important to mention that an applicant may not be eligible for appointment even if qualified the SRD-CET which is always subject to the availability of vacancy and merit. Merely issue of admit card and declaration of name in result does not guarantee final appointment which is always subject to verification of eligibility.
4. The On-line portal for application will be closed for new registration as **closing date & time mentioned under the Important Dates**. The candidature of applicants who fail to complete the online application by the stipulated date and time will not be considered and rejected. No correspondence in this regard will be entertained. However, those who have paid the examination fee by the closing date may be allowed to edit during the period of opening of the edit panel.
5. **The candidate must ensure that images of the photo, signature and thumb impression should be as per the guidelines mentioned in the 'Upload Image Instructions' given in the General links and are visible clearly in the preview at the time of filling out an application in online mode.** If the photo/signature/thumb impression image is not as per instructions given in the '**Upload Image Instructions**' in that case, your application will be rejected. Due diligence and care should be taken while uploading images of photo, signature and thumb impression.

SECTION IV: Eligibility

1. All applicants must fulfil the essential requirements of the post and other conditions stipulated in the advertisement. They are advised to satisfy themselves before applying that they possess at least the essential qualifications laid down in Annexure-III for various posts.
2. i) **To be eligible for selection** for these posts, the candidate should pass the qualifying examination by **28.02.2026** & result should be declared to this effect on or before this date. The tenure of qualifying degree should also be completing latest by **28.02.2026**.

ii) **Only those candidates** who have been / are declared successful in their qualifying degree exam/viva i.e. **DNB/MD/MS/Ph.D./M.Sc. (as applicable)** and will be completing their tenure for the same on or before **28.02.2026** will be eligible to be considered for these posts.

iii) In case of those who have appeared for exam / viva voce and result is yet to be declared then applicant will be allowed to appear in theory and/or interview provisionally. However, Result should be available by **28.02.2026**.

- iv) In cases where result of qualifying exam is declared after **28.02.2026**, their candidature will stand cancelled and no claim for selection on the basis of theory exam and Interview allowed provisionally will be considered.
- v) Compulsory days of Tenure:- 1095 days for MD/MS/MDS degree; 730 days for secondary DNB degrees
- vi) Applicants who are working in Govt. Hospital/any other Govt. Institution have to upload their NOC certificate issued from their employer. It is must to declare details of employment Govt./ Adhoc / Contract. Applicants have to display / show their NOC on the day of interview otherwise they will not be permitted for interview.

SECTION V : AGE RELAXATION

1. The Upper Age Limit for applying for **SR/SD is 45 years as on 28.02.2026**. Age relaxation is permissible to various applicants is as under (subject to foot note): -

NOTE:

- No relaxation other than those mentioned in the table above shall be applicable..
- The upper age limit in respect of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons etc. shall be relaxable in accordance with the orders issued by the Government of India from time to time.
- The upper age limit in case of Ex-serviceman and Commissioned Officers including Emergency Commissioned Officer (ECOs)/ Short Service Commissioned Officer (SSCOs) shall be relaxed by **Five years' in addition to the relaxation as mentioned in table above**, subject to the condition that on the closing date for receipt of applications the continuous service rendered in the Armed Forces by an Ex-serviceman is not less than six months after attestation. This relaxation is also available to ECOs/SSCOs who have completed their initial period of assignment of five years of Military Service and whose assignment has been extended beyond five years as on closing date and in whose case the Ministry of Defence issues certificates that they will be released within 3 months on Selection from the date of receipt of offer of appointment. Candidates claiming age relaxation under this para would be required to produce a certificate in the prescribed proforma to the Commission at the time of Interview at AIIMS New Delhi.

Note:- Ex-Serviceman who have already secured regular employment under the Central Govt. in a Civil Post are permitted the benefit of age relaxation as admissible for Ex-servicemen for securing another employment in any higher post or service under the Central Govt. However, such candidates will not be eligible for the benefit of reservation, if any for Ex-Servicemen in Central Govt. jobs.

Reservation for SC/ST/OBC/EWS/ Persons with Bench mark Disabilities (PWBD):-

- i) Reservation has been provided for the posts in accordance with Rules.
- (ii) Reservation for **Persons with Bench-mark Disabilities [PWBD]** candidates is **4%** which will be provided on horizontal basis to **Persons with Bench-mark Disabilities [PWBD]** candidates in their respective categories.

The disability certificate should be issued by a duly constituted and authorized Medical Board of the State or Central Govt. Hospitals/Institutions and countersigned by Medical Superintendent/CMO/Head of Hospital/Institution. These candidates will be evaluated by a duly constituted Medical Board to confirm eligibility.

SECTION VI : PAY SCALES

- (i) For **Medical** candidates Pay Level 11 of Pay Matrix as per 7th CPC with entry pay of Rs. 67700/- + NPA plus other usual Allowances, as applicable
- (ii) For **Non-Medical** candidates M.Sc. with Ph.D. Pay Level 10 of Pay Matrix as per 7th CPC with entry pay of Rs. 56100/- + NPA plus other usual Allowances, as applicable
- (iii) For post of Senior Demonstrators in Medical Physics (those with M.Sc.) Pay Level 6 of Pay Matrix as per 7th CPC with entry pay of Rs. 42300/- + NPA plus other usual allowances, as applicable.

SECTION VII : CERTIFICATES

CASTE/CATEGORY CERTIFICATES:

1. Validity of OBC (NCL) certificate:

OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) Certificate:- Candidates applying under the OBC category must upload an OBC (NCL) certificate in the format prescribed by DoPT O.M. dated 30.05.2014, issued by the competent authority notified in DoPT O.M. dated 08.09.1993. The certificate must confirm Non-Creamy Layer status and that the caste is included in the Central List of OBCs (ncbc.nic.in).

As per DoPT O.M. dated 31.03.2016, an OBC (NCL) certificate issued after 01 April of the relevant financial year and covering income details of the preceding three financial years shall be treated as valid. For this examination, the OBC (NCL) certificate must be:

- Valid for FY 2025–2026,
- Based on income relevant for FY 2024–2025, and
- **Issued between 01 April 2025 and 04th December 2025 (i.e last date of application).**

If the valid FY 2025–2026 certificate is not available at the time of registration, candidates must upload together in a single PDF of the following:

1. Their previous OBC (NCL) certificate, and
2. The acknowledgement/receipt of the renewal application for certificate for FY 2025-26.

The renewed FY 2025–2026 certificate must be uploaded on or before the date of the CBT Examination i.e 13.12.2025. **No correspondence will be entertained after 13.12.2025 (5:00 P.M.) in this regard.** The renewed certificate must have reference to the candidate's original caste certificate. Failure to submit the renewed certificate will lead to cancellation of candidature under the OBC category without any further notice.

- 2. Validity of EWS certificate:-** The vacancies advertised under EWS Category are as per the instructions issued by DoPT, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pension, Govt. of India, vide OM. No. 36039/1/2019-Estt (Res), dated 31.01.2019. Application under EWS category will be considered subject to submission of Income and Assets certificate on a prescribed format issued by the competent authority and subject to verification of genuineness of the certificate by the issuing authority. In pursuance to DoP&T OM No. 36039/1/2019-Estt (Res), dated 31.01.2019, a EWS certificate issued in prescribed format for employment in Central Government on the basis on income of financial year 2024-2025 issued from 01.04.2025 to last date of application i.e. 04.12.2025 (Both dates inclusive) valid for the financial year 2025-2026 will be considered valid.

3. Candidates who fail to produce valid category certificate OBC/EWS/SC/ST/PwBD, etc. during document verification or as and when required to produce the same, the candidature will be cancelled. **All candidates are advised to obtain required valid category certificate in advance to avoid cancellation of candidature at any stage of the recruitment process.**
4. For candidates who have claimed the reservation category and fail to produce a valid category certificate as applicable as per published criteria, the candidature shall be cancelled in the reserved category, and allocated seats shall be forfeited.
5. Reservation for PwBD will be as per the guidelines /Instruction contained in DoP&T OM No. 36035/02/2017-Estt (Res) dated 15.01.2018 with regard to reservation for persons with disabilities. Only such persons would be eligible for reservation under PwBD quota in service/posts who suffer from not less than 40% of physical disability. Person who wants to avail the benefit of reservation would have to submit a Disability Certificate as issued by a Competent Authority in prescribed format. However, the candidature of PwBD applicant is subject to evaluation by a Medical Board duly constituted by the competent authority. This Medical Board will evaluate suitability of candidates for the post he/she is being considered for. All the instructions of Govt. of India as amended and as applicable in this matter will be followed.

SECTION VIII: EDUCATIONAL CERTIFICATES:

1. Crucial Date for deciding eligibility will be **28.02.2026**.
2. Educational qualification certificates/Category Certificates etc. must be submitted as and when required by AIIMS New Delhi and also on the day of Interview, failing which candidature will be cancelled. No additional time will be allowed for submission and no correspondence will be entertained in this regard.
3. Those who are in employment with state/Central Govt/PSU, must submit a **"NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE"** from the employer at the time of Interview. *The Candidates will not be permitted for interview if they fail to display / show their NOC Certificate on the day of interview.*
4. If it is brought to the notice of authorities at any stage that the candidate had not submitted application through proper channel, then candidature will stand cancelled and in case of selected candidate, services will be terminated immediately.

NOTE:-Concealment of facts as above shall lead to cancellation of Candidature after appointment/ termination of service with disciplinary action.

PWBD:

1. Applicants with disabilities mentioned in Section 32 (1) of Rights of Persons with Disability Act, 2016, are eligible to apply under this category provided they have benchmark disability (equal to or more than 40%). The applicants have discretion of opting for his/her own scribe or request the Examination Section, AIIMS, New Delhi for the same and should indicate their choice at the time of registration. In case, the applicant opts for his/her own scribe, then additional information related to the scribe will be sought from applicant before the conduct of examination. Kindly note that, all candidates who have been allocated seats under PwBD category shall be examined by a **Medical Board constituted by AIIMS New Delhi** to ascertain their suitability for their selection on respective post.

Rules of Scribe and Compensatory time

The rules for scribe and compensatory time as per the OM of the Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan), Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment dated 29th August 2018, corrigendum dated 8th February, 2019 and OM dated 10th August 2022.

Eligibility for Scribe and/or compensatory time:

1. **The Persons with Benchmark Disabilities (PwBD) is defined under section 2(r) of the RPWD Act, 2016.**
 - a. Persons with Benchmark Disabilities in the categories of blindness, locomotor disability (both arms affected – BA) and cerebral palsy will be provided with the facility of a scribe if desired by the person against self-undertaking as per Appendix A Part A-1.
 - b. The PwBD candidates in the category of blindness, locomotor disability (both arms affected-BA) and cerebral palsy are allowed Compensatory Time of twenty minutes per hour of the examination if desired by the person against self-undertaking as per Appendix A Part A-1.
 - c. In the case of other categories of Persons with Benchmark Disabilities as defined under section 2(r) of the RPWD Act, 2016, the facility of scribe / Compensatory time will be allowed to such applicants on the production of a certificate to the effect that the person concerned has physical limitation in to write, and scribe is essential to write the examination on his behalf from the Chief Medical Officer/ Civil Surgeon/ Medical Superintendent of a Government Health Care institution as per the prescribed proforma (Appendix A Both part A-1 and A-2).
2. **The persons with specified disabilities covered under the definition of section 2(s) of the RPWD Act, 2016 but not covered under the definition of section 2 (r) of the said Act, i.e. persons having less than 40% disability and having difficulty in writing.**
 - a. In the case of those with less than Benchmark disabilities as defined under section 2(r) of the RPWD Act, 2016, the facility of scribe and or / Compensatory time shall be granted solely to those having difficulty in writing subject to the production of a certificate to the effect that the person concerned has physical limitation to write and that scribe is essential to write examination on his/her behalf from the competent medical authority of a Government Health Care institution as per prescribed proforma (Appendix A Both part A1 and A-3).

Note:-

1. All required certificates must be submitted within due dates as specified in the Important Dates section of this document, failing which no facilities will be provided on the day of examination.
2. The applicants have the discretion of opting for his/her scribe or requesting the Examination Section for the same and should indicate their choice at the time of Completion of the Application for the Test.
3. In case the applicant opts for his/her own scribe, then additional information related to the scribe will be sought from the applicant before the examination. The qualification of the scribe provided by the Examination Section and own scribe will be one step below the minimum qualification criteria of the Test (i.e. one step below MBBS/ equivalent medical degree). However, the qualification of the scribe will always be matriculated or above. If the applicant has opted for his/her own scribe and does not bring own scribe on the day of the examination, then it will not be possible for AIIMS to arrange a new scribe.
4. AIIMS reserve the right to not allow own scribe.
5. If the applicant has opted for his/her own scribe, the Remuneration/Honorarium/TA will be the applicant's sole responsibility.
6. The Scribe can render only assistance to the candidate, i.e., reading instructions, test paper and mouse clicks, if the candidate is not able to do so. Explanation/Interpretation of question paper is strictly prohibited and may result in cancellation of the candidature.

7. All persons eligible for scribe and/or compensatory as described above shall be provided compensatory time of not less than 20 minutes per hour of examination. In case the examination is less than an hour, the duration of compensatory time should be allowed on a pro-rata basis. Compensatory time should not be less than 5 minutes and should be in multiple of 5.

SECTION IX: APPLICATION FEES

The following fees will be applicable :-

- A) General/OBC Candidates - Rs. 3000/- (Rupees Three Thousand only)
- B) SC/ST Candidates/EWS - Rs. 2400/- (Rupees Twenty-Four Hundred only)
- C) Persons with Benchmark Disabilities - Exempted
1. The candidate can pay the prescribed application fee through DEBIT CARD/CREDIT CARD/NETBANKING. Transaction / Processing fee, if any, as applicable, will be payable to the bank by the candidate.
 2. **Application fee, once remitted, shall not be refunded under any circumstance even in case of rejection of application due to ineligibility.**
 3. Applications without the prescribed fee would not be considered and summarily rejected.
 4. **Application Fees of SC/ST candidates who appear in the Examination will be refunded in their source (debited) account after the declaration of results in due course of time.**

SECTION X : DATE & CENTRE OF EXAMINATION

Date of Examination: See Important Dates Section.

- The Recruitment Test will be conducted at cities listed below* in online [Computer Based Test (CBT)] mode only.
- Applicants should indicate his/her choice of city of examination at the time filling the application form. The city chosen is subject to confirmation of payment of the examination fee.
- The city of examination shall be allotted on first-come first-serve basis subject to availability of nodes in respective city.
- The centre of examination once chosen and allotted will not be changed and any request in this regard will not be entertained. Applicants should therefore indicate the choice of city with utmost care.
- Applicants are advised to register themselves, make payment and submit their application form at the earliest without waiting for the last date, to avoid not getting the city/centre of their choice.

SECTION XI : ADMIT CARD

- I. Admit Card will be issued 3 days before date of examination.
- II. The Admit card will be released on Examination Section (AIIMS, New Delhi) website www.aiimsexams.ac.in. Candidates are required to download their admit card from AIIMS website www.aiimsexams.ac.in by login with credentials. No admit card will be sent by post.
- III. Candidates are required to bring their admit card downloaded from website on the day of Exam at Examination Centre & handover to invigilator to mark your attendance in this Examination. Failing to do so may result in cancellation of candidature.

Note: Admit card is released/issued on the basis of information provided at the time of online application without any verification of eligibility. It is issued only to appear in the Examination and does not guarantee of eligibility/appointment/selection.

SECTION XII : PATTERN/SCHEME/SYLLABUS OF EXAMINATION

Examination will be conducted in two stages as per following: -

- ✓ Stage-I: Computer Based Test (CBT)
- ✓ Stage-II : Interview

1. **Mode and SCHEME OF MARKING**

a) **CBT online test (Stage-I)**

- The Recruitment Examination for SRD-CET will be conducted in a computer based test (CBT) mode.
- A candidate can apply in any one subject / speciality as advertised .Syllabus will be as applicable for qualification for the post.

Duration	:	90 minutes
No. of questions	:	80 MCQs in the subject concerned.
Type of Questions	:	Multiple Choice questions
Correct Answer	:	One mark (+1)
Negative Marking	:	Not applicable

- No marks will be awarded for the questions not answered or Marked for Review (*Questions marked for review shall be considered as unanswered*).
- Question paper will be provided in the online Test as Subject/Group applied in the Registration/application form. No further change in Subject/Group after the submitting the Examination Fee.
- The Competitive Entrance Examination will have one paper in English language consisting of 80 (Eighty) Objective Type (Multiple Choice type) questions covering the concerned speciality.
No Clarification will be offered on technical aspect of question during examination If any discrepancy in any question is found in the Entrance Examination, the candidate is advised to write to Associate Dean (Exam), AIIMS, New Delhi – 110 029 within 24 hours through the link enabled in their MyPage under Section Representation for Questions (RFQ). The link will remain enabled for 24 hours after the completion of the Examination.

b) **Interview (Stage-II)**

- The Interview will carry 20 marks.

SECTION XIII : Method of Resolving Ties, Preparation of Merit List & Allocation of Seats

1. The merit list(s) for all categories i.e. SC/ST/OBC/UR/EWS shall be prepared on the basis of combined marks of online test and interview.
2. All Tie cases (more than one candidate having same marks) will be resolved on date of birth. Older candidate (earlier date of birth) is ranked above younger candidate.
3. Centre Allocation will be based on order of preference of choices (wherever applicable) in order of merit and applicable category.
4. AIIMS, New Delhi reserves the right to invite choices at any time during the process of recruitment.

SECTION XIV : SUBMISSION OF APPLICATION BY CANDIDATES WHO ARE EMPLOYED

The Institute does not have any objection if the candidates in employment apply directly for the above Recruitment Test. However, all such candidates should inform their employer in writing that they are applying for this Recruitment Test. They should also sign the undertaking in the downloaded copy of Registration Slip that they have informed their employer about the submission of the application to AIIMS at the time of Interview. If any communication is received from their department/office withholding permission to the candidate's appearing to the Recruitment Test, the candidature/admission of the candidate will be cancelled, and no further correspondence in this regard will be entertained.

SECTION XV : Eligibility & Document Verification at the time of Interview

1. The original certificates/documents of provisionally selected candidates will be verified at the time of Interview and at the time of reporting/joining also. On the basis of the CBT Examination, the provisionally qualified candidates will be required to produce original certificates as given below, along with one set of photocopy of all these documents, which are, duly attested/self-attested on the day of Interview. Documents required are as follows:-
 - (i) Copy of downloaded Admit Card.
 - (ii) Certificate showing the Date of Birth.

 - (vii) Completion of tenure [1095 days for MD/MS/MDS; and 730 days for secondary DNB degree] and passing proof.

Only those candidates whose certificates are found to be in order shall be permitted to appear for interview.

2. Failure to submit any essentially required document as mentioned above will lead to cancellation of candidature and forfeiture of allocated seat.

SECTION XVI : GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. Canvassing in any form will be a disqualification.
2. Any criteria, eligibility, process etc not expressly mentioned stands not allowed/applicable.
3. After selection on any advertised posts place of posting will be subject matter of applicable rules in AIIMS.
4. In anticipation of the huge number of applicants, scrutiny of the eligibility criteria etc. may not be undertaken at the time of Recruitment Examination. Therefore, the applications are accepted provisionally only. The candidates are advised to go through the requirements of educational

7. In case of failure in identity verification or candidates opt to remain absent from identity verification the appointment will be cancelled. Action will be taken as per rules including inclusion in debarred list for examination.
8. Any dispute in regard to any matter related to conduct of examination referred to herein shall be subject to the jurisdiction of Delhi Courts alone.
9. AIIMS reserves the right to cancel, change clause, not to appoint on post including change in posts and its vacancy.

SECTION XVII : LEGAL AND DISCIPLINARY ACTION

Legal and disciplinary action will be initiated by AIIMS, New Delhi against persons who are found to be guilty of misconduct for reasons mentioned below (including but not limited to)

- A. Obtaining support for his/her candidature by the following means, namely: —offering illegal gratification to; or applying pressure on; or blackmailing, or threatening to blackmail any person connected with the conduct of the examination; or
- B. Impersonation; or Procuring impersonation by any person; or
- C. Any act or attempt to act or assistance in any act or attempt to act in any manner by any one including candidate from computer console/question paper etc; to transmit question outside or talking or looking into computer screen of other or moving question with fast speed without any intention to read question, or
- D. Submitting fabricated documents or documents which have been tampered with; or
- E. Providing false information regarding educational qualifications and/or experience (such as internship completion) for the sole purpose of appearing in the examination for practice or any other purposes; or
- F. Uploading irrelevant photos in the application form in place of actual photo/signature/left thumb impression; or
- G. Uploading morphed/digitally modified photos for the purpose impersonation; or
- H. Making statements which are incorrect or false or suppressing material information; or
- I. Resorting to the following means in connection with his candidature for the examination, namely: obtaining questions through improper means; finding out the particulars of the persons connected with secret work relating to the examination; influencing the personnel involved with conduct of examination.
- J. Being in possession of or using unfair means during the examination;
- K. Copying the questions, misbehaving in the examination hall including tearing of the scripts, provoking fellow examinees to boycott examination, creating a disorderly scene and the like; or

- L. Harassing or doing bodily harm to the staff deputed by Examination Section, Staff employed by Vendors for the purpose of conduct of examination.
- M. Being in possession of or using any mobile phone, (even in switched off mode), pager or any electronic equipment or programmable device or storage media like pen drive, smart watches etc. or camera or Bluetooth devices or any other equipment or related accessories either in working or switched off mode capable of being used as a communication device during the examination; or
- N. Violating any of the instructions issued to candidates along with their admission certificates permitting them to take the examination; or
- O. Changing seats/question paper/any devices and changing computer screen/Mouse/keyboard without proper permission.
- P. Disputing terms of advertisement after participation in the examination.
- Q. Attempting to commit or, as the case may be, abetting the commission of all or any of the acts specified in the foregoing clauses; may in addition to rendering himself liable to criminal prosecution, be liable: —
 - i. To be disqualified by the AIIMS, New Delhi from this/or other Examinations for which he/she is a candidate; and/or
 - ii. To be debarred either permanently or for a specified period: —
 - a. By the Examination Section, AIIMS, New Delhi, from any examination or selection held by them;
 - b. Any other penalty as per discretion of competent authority.
 - iii. If he/she is already in service under Government to disciplinary action under the appropriate rules.

Provided that no penalty under this section shall be imposed except after:—

- i) Giving the candidate an opportunity of making such representation in writing as he/she may wish to make in that behalf; and
- ii) Taking the representation, if any, submitted by the candidate within the period allowed to her/him into consideration.
- iii) However, depending upon the seriousness of the matter, AIIMS reserves the right to cancel candidature without issuing notice/assigning reasons for the use of Unfair means during and examination at the discretion of the Director, AIIMS, New Delhi, and no correspondence will be entertained.

Any person who is found by the AIIMS, New Delhi to be guilty of colluding with a candidate (s) in committing or abetting the commission of any of the misdeeds listed at Clauses 21. A to 21 P above render himself liable to action in terms of the Clause Q.

Legal Jurisdiction

AIIMS New Delhi is not responsible for any issues on recruitment rules, relaxation, delay in joining, rejection on grounds on eligibility, document verification, extension of time, withdrawal of seats etc.

Any dispute in regard to any matter related to conduct of examination referred to herein shall be subject to the jurisdiction of Delhi Courts alone.
